**Bylaw # 1307/18 to establish alternate methods
for advertising notices**

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, it is the intention of the Council of the Town of Nanton to consider adoption of Bylaw #1307/18, being a bylaw to establish alternate methods of advertising statutory notices, as per Section 606.(1) of the Municipal Government Act, at the Regular Meeting of Council to be held Tuesday, September 4, 2018, as follows:

The purpose of the proposed amendment is to reach a broader audience of our residents by providing for alternate methods of advertising to include electronic means such as web site posting, social media, digital signboard, bulletin boards, etc., in addition to or instead of newspaper ads.

Anyone wishing to make a presentation regarding the proposed bylaw must have written presentations into the Town Office no later than 12:00 noon **Friday, August 31, 2018** to be included in the agenda package. Council may agree to hear anyone wishing to comment on the matter at the public hearing; however, if additional material is being presented to council, please provide 10 copies at time of presentation.
