Attention Homeowners and Occupants,

Please be advised that Newhook Trenching Ltd will be doing underground utility work in your community on behalf of Fortis Alberta from November 5 to November 16, 2018, weather permitting. The work is to upgrade the existing buried power lines in your alley and is required in order to continue to provide your community with dependable power service.

The work will take place in the your alley between __17__ Street and __18__ Street and could possibly require a full closure of the alley between the dates provided. We understand the inconvenience of a full closure and we will first attempt to close the alley only during working hours, between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on weekdays. We will work with all residents to communicate our specific requirements in advance of any closures, but during working hours you will not have access to the alley and will not be able to remove any vehicles due to open trenches and other excavations. We will have measures on hand to deal with any unforeseen emergencies, but please understand that that we will only be able to reopen the alley for true emergencies.

During this time Newhook Trenching Ltd requests that all residents affected by the construction please adhere to all posted signage. All signage, cones, etc. are in place to protect the public, property, and our workers so please respect our efforts to work safely.
