A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE TOWN OF NANTON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH ALTERNATE METHODS FOR ADVERTISING STATUTORY NOTICES

1. PURPOSE:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, and any amendments thereto, a Council must give notice of certain bylaws, resolutions, meetings, public hearings or other things by advertising in a newspaper or other publication circulating in the area, mailing or delivering a notice to every residence in the affected area or by another method provided for in a bylaw under Section 606.1;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 606.1(1) of the Municipal Government Act, a council may, by bylaw, provide for one or more methods, which may include electronic means, for advertising proposed bylaws, resolutions, meetings, public hearings and other things referred to in Section 606;

AND WHEREAS, Council is satisfied that the advertising method set out in this Bylaw is likely to bring matters advertised by that method to the attention of substantially all residents in the area to which the bylaw, resolution or other thing relates or in which the meeting or hearing is to be held;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Nanton, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

2. SHORT TITLE:

This Bylaw # 1307 /18 shall be referred to as the Town of Nanton Public Notification Bylaw.

3. ADVERTISING METHODS:

Any notice required to be advertised under Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act of a bylaw, resolution, meeting, public hearing or other thing may be given, in accordance with the timelines prescribed in Section 606, as follows:

- electronically, by posting the notice prominently on the Town of Nanton's Official website, and/or
- electronically, by posting the notice prominently on any of the Town of Nanton's official social media sites, and/or
- by posting the notice prominently on the bulletin board provided for that purpose at the Town of Nanton Administrative Office, and/or
- by posting the notice prominently on the roadside digital signboard located at the north and south highway entrances to the Town of Nanton,

as alternate methods of advertising, either instead of, or in addition to, the provisions of Section 606(2)(a) and (b) of the Act, being publishing in a newspaper or other publication circulating in the area, or mailing or delivering a notice to every residence in the affected area.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE AND READINGS

4.1 This Bylaw #1307/18 comes into effect upon the date of final reading and signing thereof.
